Rockcote Armour

Description:

Armour is an acrylic based paint for use over a variety of textures.

Typical Use:

Typically used over acrylic based textures.

Expectation:

It is a durable attractive finish.

Limitations:

Not suitable for application over wood based substrates. It requires a minimum of 1 coat of armour over acrylic texture and 2 coats of armour over a sealer when painting over mineral texture.

Technical Data:

Mix ratio: 15L and 4L
Coverage: approx. 3.5m²
Substrates: mineral and acrylic textures
Abrasive strength: Excellent
Vapour Permeability: No vapour barrier formed.

Surface Preparation:

Ensure surface is clean, sound, dry and free from dust, dirt, grease, mould and lichen.

Application:

Armour is applied using a roller.

Curing:

Armour should be protected from hot drying winds and direct sunlight for the first 2 hours. Protect newly applied paint from rain and water run off for the first 24 hours.

Clean up:

Wash equipment and spills as soon as possible with water.

Environmental and Safety

Ensure washing water does not enter waterways. Wet waste can be soaked into land or disposed of in trade waste. Material Safety Data Sheets are available on request.
